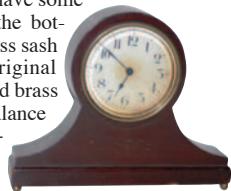


792X. \$50
Ships clock on a stand. This is a modern copy of an old ships clock, with wheel, on a brass stand. It is 7" tall, back and base are wood, front, sides, and wheel, are metal. Backwind and set movement is running. The dial is signed, "U.S.Navy". Nice little novelty clock. \$50-\$100.

French miniature tambour clock. Case is almost 9" wide, 7" high, retaining the original finish on the mahogany case, but it does have some scuffed marks, mainly on the bottom. Four brass ball feet, brass sash with a beveled glass, original hands, and paper dial. Hinged brass back door, brass 8 day balance movement is running. \$50-\$100.



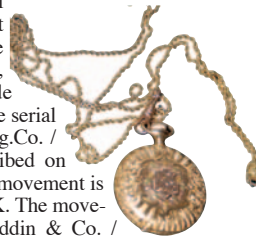

Lamp Post clock, a copy of the poplar Swiss miniature lamp post clock. The metal case is 12" high, complete with the street sign, imitation street light on top and the clock in the center. It is running, and has a back wind and set movement. The last original Lamp Post clock we sold was missing the street sign. The originals seem to bring \$450-\$600 on eBay. \$50-\$100.

"Patek, Philippe & Cie / Geneve", signed on the perfect porcelain dial of this size 16 pocket watch. They have produced some of the world's most desirable and collectable watches, and were generally made for a high class of clientele. The time only movement is running. Movement and case are bright and clean. The movement is signed, "Patek, Philippe & Cie / No 2 / 12119 / Geneve, Suisse", and "Spaulding & Co. / Chicago". The lid over the dial has an engraved design or initials on the outside, inside marked, "16". The back cover on the inside, is signed, "121191 / Spaulding & Co. Chicago". On the outside of the lid covering the movement is marked, "From Elizabeth / January 1, 1906", and "Spaulding & Co Chicago / No.121191". On the inside of that lid is the serial number again and "1 8", with the symbol for gold between the 1 and 8. There is some normal marks from carrying the watch, on the outside, otherwise near perfect. 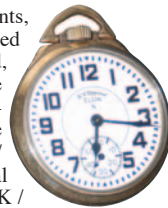

"E. V. Roddin & Co., Chicago", signed on the porcelain dial of this beautiful size 12 ladies watch. It is a Hunter case with heavy engraving on both lids. The top has initials; the back has a small diamond within a 6 point star. Signed on the inside of the front cover is, "140154". Signed inside the back cover is the same serial number and, "W.W.C.Mfg.Co. / 14K / Warranted". Inscribed on the inside cover over the movement is the serial number and 14K. The movement is signed, "E.V.Roddin & Co. / Chicago", and "10563482 / Safety Barrel". A gold chain is attached to the watch that is 24 inches, double strand, with an adjustable or sliding latch on the end. The slip latch also has a small diamond on it. \$1500-\$2000.

The E. Howard Watch Co. pocket watch, 12 size, 17 Jewels, Model 1908. It is in its original factory box, with a complete label, indicating it sold new for \$40. The serial numbers on the case and watch are a match. The movement is running, and is signed, "E. Howard Watch Co. / 1091051 / Boston, U.S.A.". It is marked 3 Position Adj. The back lid is signed, "C.W.C.Co. / 2220604", the inner back lid is signed Howard and "Crescent Extra". The very nice porcelain dial is signed simply, "Howard". \$300-\$500.



804. \$200
"B.W.Raymond / Elgin", signed on the dial and movement of this size 16, open face, pocket watch. It has 21Jewels, 9 adjustments, gold center train, has been cleaned and is running. Railroad approved, movement is 571 Grade. All those facts are inscribed on the movement. Very nice dial and hands. The back cover is inscribed, "3055 / Cased and Timed by Elgin National Watch Co / Keystone / J. Boss / 10K / Gold Filled / K0000002". \$300-\$500.

Waltham size 16, rare pocket watch, Riverside Maximum, one the most collectable pocket watches. The case is 14K, 23 jewels, and a real Hunter case, engraved 12 point deer on one cover, and brush to hide in, on the other cover. The very nice dial is signed simply, "Waltham". The inside cover over the dial is signed, "Keystone / 14K / 5127841". The back cover is signed the same, and the inner cover is signed, "Walter W. Zuehlke", and the inside of the cover over the movement is signed, "Guaranteed / 14K / 585 Fine / The K.W.C.Co. / 5127841". There is a gold chain with the watch, 11" long. This watch is rated 3 star. \$2500-\$3000.

Watch holder with an old watch. Porcelain holder is 5" tall, has a slot to insert the watch from the back. Neither the dial or movement signed, but on the inside of the double back cover it is signed, "Fuda Watch Co. / Swiss". I would not think the watch would be worth anything, the dial is bad, there are three very nice hands however, and the case is worn. On one side is a small flaw in the porcelain. I would not call it a crack or break, for if it were it would be more serious. The hunter is struggling pulling the deer home. \$100-\$200.

Waltham Watch Co. 18 Size, 15 Jewels, silver case. Porcelain dial signed only, "Waltham", has a hairline from 4 to 8. Movement signed, "Appleton, Tracy & Co. / Waltham, Mass. / Adjusted / 3739380". It is running. Deer stag engraved on the back. Inside the back are the inscriptions, "Keystone / Watch Case / Guaranteed / Silver / Genuine / 1955805". \$50-\$100.

Waltham Watch Co. 16 Size, 15 Jewels, Hunter case. Owner says it is a Waltham but I do not see the name on the dial or movement. Crystal cracked, movement is running, signed only, "15 Jewels / Adjusted". Initials engraved on the back lid. Inside of the lids are signed, "2052472 / Guaranteed / Gold Filled / And To Wear / 10 Years". "Star Watch Case Co.". Case shows wear and tarnish. \$50-\$100.

"American Waltham, U.S.A.", signed on the movement of this 16 Size Hunter case watch. The movement is also signed, "15 Jewels", and it is running. Porcelain dial is good and is signed, "Waltham". Serial number on the lids is, "1822418". Engraving on front and back. Inner lid over the movement is signed, "Wadsworth / Warranted / 20 Years / Made For / Equity Watch Co. / Boston". \$50-\$100.

Waltham, open face pocket watch, size 12, 15 jewels, silver case, colored dial. Dial is signed, "Waltham". The movement is signed, "Waltham / 15 Jewels / U.S.A. / 24857874". It is running. Inside lid is signed, "Wadsworth / Quality / 6936433". No engraving on the back. \$50-\$100.

Waltham open face pocket watch, size 18, 21 Jewels. The very nice porcelain dial is signed only, "Waltham". The movement is running, signed, "Crescent St. / Waltham, Mass. / 21 Jewels / Adjusted / Safety Barrel / 9009572". Inside back lid is signed, "Warranted / B&B / Royal / 20 Years / 3509675". There is no engraving on the case. The movement is clean, case is bright gold, movement is running strong. \$200-\$300.

Waltham open face pocket watch, size 12, 15 jewels. The movement is very clean and is running. Signed, "A. W. W. Co. / Waltham, Mass. / 15 Jewels / 23341147". The porcelain dial has a faint hairline a 8, and is signed, "Waltham / U.S.A." The lid is signed, "Warranted / B&B / Royal / 20 Years / 6638903". The inside of the lid has circular designs all over. The outside of the lid has engraved designs all over. Case is very nice, clean and polished. \$50-\$100.
